Eligibility

• Open to currently enrolled **graduate** students in the Division of Communication Disorders at the University of Wyoming.

Award

• Scholarships will be awarded to eligible **graduate** students to off-set the costs of tuition, books, and supplies. Awardees will be notified via e-mail in late April. Funds will be dispersed before the next academic semester.

Application materials

- 1. A copy of current transcript (unofficial/WYO WEB format is acceptable)
- 2. Typed-written statement that <u>includes</u> the following information: (no more than two typed pages; double-spaced; 12-point font)
- Brief biography (i.e., tell us who you are and how you came to be in this profession)
- Statement of professional goals (i.e., *after* completing graduate school)
- A response to the following statement:
