Eligibility

- Open to currently enrolled **SLPA** students at Laramie County Community College.

Award

- Scholarships will be awarded to eligible **SLPA** students to off-set the costs of tuition, books and supplies. Awards will be announced during the spring semester. Funds will be dispersed before the next academic semester.

Application materials

1. Typed-written statement that includes the following information: *(no more than two typed pages; double-spaced; 12-point font)*
 - *Brief* biography (i.e., tell us who you are and how you came to be in this profession)
 - Statement of professional goals (i.e., *after* completing SLPA program)
 - A response to the following statement:
